Poca at Nitro

The last two meetings between these neighboring rivals have been high-scoring **Nitro** victories - 38-35 last year and 48-33 in 2007. It could be more of the same tonight.

Poca, 2-8 last year, returns running back Caleb Arthur, who had 1,801 yards and 17 TDs, and versatile QB Jason Cuffee. **Nitro** has Mark Chandler, who ran for 647 yards and seven TDs and threw for 503 yards and four scores in a 3-7 season.

"It boils down to depth," said **Poca** coach Bob Lemley. "There were times last year when we looked pretty good and times when kids went down and it put a hole in the bubble a little bit. This year, we hope we have enough running backs or whatever when someone gets tired or something happens, so we don't fall down too far."
